In the modern day, geothermal energy is being used in 3 spheres of technology: heating and cooling buildings through geothermal heat pumps, generating electricity through geothermal power plants, and heating structures through directly usable applications.

The first geothermal plant was set up in 1904 in Larderello, Italy and it still produces power.

Geothermal energy is clean, renewable, reliable and cost-effective. However, its availability is often limited in areas near tectonic plate boundaries.
